2021-2022 WinterKids App Survey Results

- 55% of kids tried a new winter sport this year!
 - 44% tried alpine skiing or snowboarding for the first time
 - 8% tried XC skiing for the first time
 - 3% tried ice skating or snowshoeing for the first time
- 70% said the WinterKids App helped increase the number of days they were outside
