

This year was a notable year of anniversaries: the 10-year anniversary of our winter kick-off event, License to Chill, the 5-year anniversary of the popular WinterKids Winter Games in Maine schools, and the 10-year anniversary of the WinterKids Downhill 24 ski challenge fundraiser at Sugarloaf. We also revamped the WinterKids Guide to Outdoor Active Learning and reintroduced it as a new and improved Learn Outside Guide. All told, we increased our reach by 92% and reached 51,240 kids, parents, and teachers this year with an array of unique, outdoor programs to help them stay active and discover the joy of winter activities in Maine, New Hampshire and beyond. The Winter Games offers four weeks of spirited competition for elementary students: outdoor physical activity, nutrition, family engagement and winter carnival. The 5th annual Winter Games offered two tracks: 22 schools across Maine competed for \$50,000 in cash prizes, and an additional 106 communities played along for weekly incentives and prizes. All told, over 42,280 kids and teachers have participated in the Winter Games in the last 5 years.


