

# End-of-Season Gear Care Checklist



## Jackets & Snowpants

- Wash according to care labels (use technical wash if recommended)
- Fully air dry before storing
- Store loosely in a cool, dry place *(avoid vacuum sealing technical outerwear)*
- Reapply DWR treatment if water no longer beads on the fabric



## Helmets

- Wipe down the shell and interior padding
- Remove and wash liners if removable
- Store somewhere cool and out of direct sunlight
- Avoid stacking heavy items on top



## Gloves & Mittens

- Make sure they are completely dry inside and out
- Use boot/glove dryers if needed
- Store in a breathable bin or bag
- Clip pairs together so they don't wander off over the summer



## Ski & Snowboard Boots

- Remove liners and dry thoroughly.
- Buckle shells loosely to maintain shape.
- Store in a dry, moderate-temperature space *(Avoid basements that may get damp.)*



## Goggles

- Do not wipe the inside lens *(this can damage anti-fog coating)*
- Let them air dry fully
- Store in a protective soft bag
- Keep in a temperature-stable area to protect lens coatings



## Bonus Tip:

**If your skis or snowboard took a beating this season, consider a summer wax before storage to protect the bases.**
